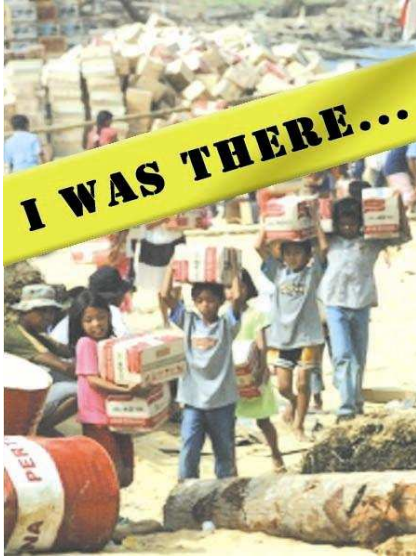


# TEACHER'S GUIDE

<b>Suggested Level</b>	Secondary 1-2 (7 <sup>th</sup> -8 <sup>th</sup> grade)
<b>Length</b>	55 minutes (1 period)
<b>Subjects</b>	English, language of instruction
<b>Broad Areas of Learning</b>	Citizenship and community life
<b>Focuses of Development</b>	Peace culture
<b>Educational Aim</b>	Encourage the students to question the importance of Canadian international development aid, notably during the urgent situation created by the 2004 tsunami in Indonesia.
<b>Subject-Specific Competencies</b>	To write self-expressive, narrative and information-based texts : prepare an interview, elaborating on numerous questions
<b>Cross-Curricular Competencies</b>	To use information To communicate appropriately

## Background Information

The student is given the role of a journalist on the local student radio station, interviewing a Canadian aid worker who witnessed the situation in Indonesia the day after the 2004 tsunami. He or she must create ten pertinent and complete interview questions that would help the young listeners of the station to realize the value of Canadian humanitarian aid in countries affected by the 2004 tsunami.

## Instructions

Based on personal knowledge of the situation in Indonesia, and on general information provided in the above text, the student must introduce each of his or her questions with a descriptive sentence. This sentence should provide incomplete information that leads the student to question the guest in order to learn more.
