Background Information

A: Project Summary

This internship is financed by the Canadian International Development Agency (CIDA) through the International Youth Internship Program. The project contributes to the electrification of schools and medical clinics in remote regions of Cuba, thus enhancing access to education and health care. You will work in direct collaboration with the Cuban organisations involved in this task, and at all stages will be accompanied by a team of Cuban and Canadian workers.

B: Responsibilities Related to the Internship

- Become familiar with the mission of the organisation and its activities
- Create educational tools focused on renewable energy in order to enhance awareness amongst young Canadians of these environmentally responsible and economic technologies
- Collaborate in the preparation and presentation of a technical training session on solar panel installation. This training will be directed towards Cuban personel working with the intern
- Participate in studies and research concerning renewable energy
- Aid with the installation of solar systems in remote regions, for schools and medical clinics
- Become familiar with practices and norms related to renewable energy
- Ensure an exchange of skills related to practices and norms

The intern will receive a daily living allowance for the full duration of the internship. The selected person must also complete a fundraising effort to help finance the internship before his or her depart for Cuba.
